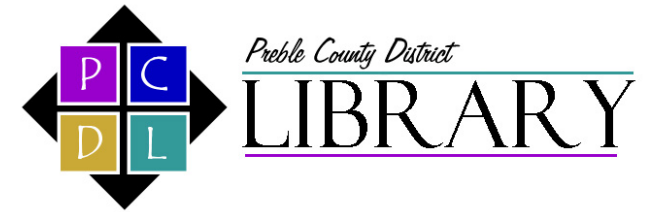

Your Educator Card

Programs & Misc.

Materials & Services

To be eligible to receive an Educator Card you must:

- ◆ **Teach** at either a public or private school, daycare, Head Start, or Sunday school; or be a homeschool educator.
- ◆ Have a **personal library card** (Required)
- ◆ **You must visit your local PCDL branch in person to receive an Educator Card**

You must have your educator card to:

- ◆ Borrow materials

Cost of the educator card:

- ◆ Your first card is **free**.
- ◆ A replacement card is \$1

Loan Periods:

- ◆ **Six (6) weeks.**
- ◆ **Renewals: one (1) time** for an additional **three (3) wks.**
- You can borrow up to **75 items**
- Because of limited resources, **popular materials are limited to the normal due date.** Your educator card is for materials that are on the subject being taught during your class time. Please use your **personal library card** for pleasure reading that does not involve directly educating the child. Your cooperation helps our library keep materials equally available to all our children.
- If materials are not returned by the due date, fines will be charged
- Misuse of the Educator Card will result in the removal of this privilege.



◆ **Special Programs & visits**

Our librarians are available by appointment to visit your school, HeadStart or daycare. We also host class visits and provide tours and programs. Please make an appointment to insure that ample staff is available to assist you.

◆ **StoryTime**

Infant/toddler, pre-school and elementary story times are provided at many of our libraries. A story and related craft are presented. We offer fall, winter and spring sessions. Registration required.

◆ **Summer Reading Program**

Each year our Summer Reading Program provides incentives to encourage children to retain the reading skills learned during the school year.

◆ **Library & Preschool Partners (LAPP)**

The **LAPP program** is a joint effort by the libraries, Head Start, the Extension Office, pre-schools and daycares in the county to encourage reading activities with young children. Interested Daycare facilities may contact Teresa Deaton to learn more about the LAPP Book Program.

◆ **Tutoring space**

Limited space is available in our libraries to meet with your students. The Eaton Branch has a small room which can be reserved.



◆ **Large print and talking books**

We provide an assortment of children's fiction in large print. Our **Outreach Department** handles the distribution of talking book machines and audiotapes for our visually or physically impaired residents.

◆ **Parent/teacher resource collection**

We own a wide variety of supplemental teaching aids for just about any subject.

◆ **Classroom collections**

If you have a special topic or wish an assortment of titles, call or visit any PCDL library branch to obtain a request form. Please allow 2 weeks advance notice for classroom collections.

◆ **Homework and reference assistance**

Think of us **before** you make an assignment. We will be glad to locate, set aside and limit the number of books on a topic so all your students will have access to the information. We also have access to a number of full-text web based resources.

◆ **On-line catalog & beyond**

Our combined database of over 260,000 items includes the holdings of the **Gratis Library, all Preble County School Districts**, as well as our **eight library branch locations**. Materials may be placed on hold at any location or from anywhere via the Internet. The requested materials are delivered to our libraries and partners weekdays. We also have an agreement with other libraries to borrow materials not included in our catalog, as well as participating in **Ohio Shares: MORE** the statewide resource sharing network.
